Meeting for all parents, staff and governors – 22nd January 7.30pm

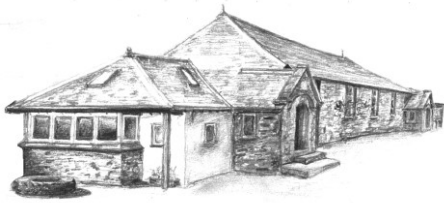
